Recreation in Czech law

- Czech Nature Conservation and Landscape Protection Act (No. 114/1992)
- Forest Act (No. 289/1995)
- clear in general, problematic in detailed view
- not enough clarification from ministries
- ANCLPCR (Board of Specialists on Recreation, Sports and Tourism) – methodology for PLA authorities



Designated places



Free access to the landscape

- § 63 NCLP Act, to forests § 19 FA
- movement freedom
- walkers √ with dogs? horse-riders? bikers?
- § no harm to the owner agreement for permanent usage (applicable only to horse-

riders)

Conclusions

- recommended explanations, different usage of inactments possible (e. g. in NP)
- different restrictions should be explainable by site conditions
- some law changes needed
- nature conservation bureaus should respect recreation as a way of ecological self-education
